Could I please register an objection to the above planning application, which is for a take away food outlet on the Quarter Deck at Robin-Hoods-Bay. I apologise for the delay in making these comments, but I have only just become aware of the application, and I understand that no decision has yet been made.

My concerns are as follows:

- 1) This is a natural area, available for all visitors to sit and watch the view of the beach and Ravenscar. If it is being used as an eating establishment the amount of space for other visitors will be limited, and people will not want to be surrounded by other people eating and drinking. More bins will be needed which will fill up the area even more. Surely this should be available for everybody to use for sitting, not one eating establishment.
- 2) From the description this looks as though it is a permanent chalet, so will be visible all year round in an area which is a wild area for birds and animals. It is not appropriate to put a building on it.
- 3) There are already a number of take away outlets in Bay - I understand that a lot of the shops and cafes do take away and Bay has rapidly been turned into a **theme park** rather than a residential village which is appreciated for its natural beauty. Please don't allow this to be pushed even further, by having even more. I know both fish and chip shops do take aways and the sweet shop in the dock, as well as most of the cafes and pubs.
