I am writing with reference to the planning application for the tea hut on the quarterdeck, Robin Hoods Bay, reference number %2018/0177%. I am wishing to highlight a matter which I feel may have been missed on the application. The proposed site for the tea hut currently has a fairly substantial ash tree which has ash dieback disease, and a sea buckthorn which large enough to be classed as a tree (the trunk measures a diameter of 11cm at a height of 1.5m). There is also a large hawthorne which I feel may be affected during construction although it is sited slightly outside of the designated area for the building. I am only writing to highlight these trees as the applicant has clearly stated there are no trees on the site on his application. I feared mentioning the issue at the committee meeting may be a little late notice.
