23. Pre-application Advice

The internal rearrangement of the accommodation offered within the existing building and minor repairs to the exterior of the building will not require the benefit of planning permission. However any external changes such as the alterations to the door and window arrangements that materially affect the external appearance of the building will require planning permission. From the drawings submitted with your enquiry I have no objection to the proposed alterations and anticipate that any future planning application is likely to receive favourable consideration.

2). Demolition of chalet building and its replacement with motorhome pitches and garden

This will require planning permission and is likely to receive favourable consideration given that the works would result in an improvement of the tourism accommodation on offer within an existing site with no physical expansion to the site.

3). Installation of an outdoor check-in stand.

This will require the benefit of planning permission but given its discrete location within the holiday park itself I would anticipate such an application receiving favourable consideration.
