## Comments:

I have read the Bat Survey by Wold Ecology from June 2018 which details a number of visits to the site including scoping and emergence surveys. One further survey will be required in August or September. However sufficient information is available to show that a European Protected Species Licence will be required as 5 bat roosts are present in the barns. A full licence application to Natural England will be required rather than a low impact application due to the number of roosts present, one of which is a maternity roost.

Planning permission can be given with a condition that the EPSL is shown to the NYMNPA before development works start.

Before the development hereby permitted commences, the applicant/ecological consultant shall forward a copy of the Natural England European Protected Species Licence covering approved mitigation to the National Park Authority.
