Whilst the reduction in the number of dormer windows from three to two is welcomed, concerns about the construction of dormers on the front elevation of a historic building which contributes to the architectural and historic character and appearance of the conservation area remain in principle.

With regards to the use of pvc windows, concerns previously expressed with respect to non-traditional aspects of pvc including bulkier profiles and artificial woodgrain plastic surface remain, notwithstanding the replacement of top hung casements with sash style windows.

Note to the Planning Officer:

In assessing the submitted proposals and reaching its recommendation the Local Highway Authority has taken into account the following matters:

The local Highway Authority has considered the impact on the publicly maintainable highway that the application would have compared to the current layout. The replacement windows should have no additional impact on the highway on the understanding that they do not open outwards over the footway.

It should be noted that the existing bay window does already extend out over the highway. The applicant has stated that the existing bay window has been in place for many years and we are not aware of any issues caused by this. The width of the available footway is no less than that outside neighbouring properties due to steps outside the front doors. However, it is still an obstruction extending out over the publicly maintainable highway.

Consequently the Local Highway Authority recommends that the following **Condition** is attached to any permission granted:
