Further to our telephone conversation earlier today, please find attached a copy of drawing FSS000/021 showing proposed strengthening and repairs (including Section BB) for the Cupola. As noted, this drawing is to be read in conjunction with the Structural Engineer's proposals included in The Design and Access Statement, Appendix A. I trust this provides the information you need, please do let me know if you require anything more.

I also attach a copy of drawing FSS000/020, as previously submitted. As discussed, it is proposed only to adjust the gutter so it flows west (to the right of the photo) so it will remain in its existing position. The proposals also include for removing the Nave east (LHS) down pipe, and replace the west (RHS) down pipe with 100mm diameter cast iron. 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
