Whilst I appreciate that the variation in colour is done as to mimic stonework; this effect is very difficult to achieve. As the majority of the elevation to which the orangery will attach is constructed in brick, I have concerns that a variation in colour will not sit well with the existing materials. Typically orangeries attached to brick buildings are white, with coloured orangeries more common on stone or white washed buildings. Bearing in mind the information submitted I would prefer for the whole development to be consistently white painted to the timber sections. I believe this will achieve a better finish and not be at odds with the host building.
