Dear Hilary,

Following our recent communications regarding the application at land adjacent to Tall Trees, Hay Lane, I can confirm that the means of access into the field has not changed. It is in the same place as the original and that the ground level is unaltered. I feel it worth mentioning that our clients noted the road level increased when it was resurfaced and this has caused rainwater to wash into the field. Consequently, our client notified the highways agency of the rainwater and this has resulted in the current situation regarding the entrance.

For the avoidance of doubt an area of land was levelled to allow the Polytunnel to be erected. I have attached a photo showing the extent of earth removal for the Polytunnel

As requested I have also attached the revised site location plan and I have copied Wendy in on the email.
