Regarding the above planning permission, work on replacing our only bathroom has now commenced.

The enclosed application, 'for a non-material amendment following a grant of planning permission', concerns moving the small existing, (510mm x 900mm), south facing window, (it's location shown on picture 2 of the original application), and placing it in the exact same southerly position, but located on the newly built replacement south facing wall.

To help visualise the amendment we are requesting please see the enclosed digitally enhanced images.

Picture A;

shows the existing small window's exact location at present.

Picture B;

shows the exact proposed 'amended' location on the replacement wall, (with the existing surrounding clematis also replanted).

The relocating of the existing small window was discussed at length with the building inspector Mike Helm, and he fully approved the measure, (in principle), agreeing it would give additional much needed light to the bathroom interior. It would also enhance, and link the existing house frontage window line.

The bathroom under construction will eventually enable my disabled husband easier access to all facilities; with the interior layout being changed to include a walk in shower, and a wider doorway for 'future proofing'.

However, at present we are without any bathroom facilities, and are constricted to using a chemical toilet, (and for all our washing needs the kitchen sink). I would therefore really appreciate a prompt response to this amendment application, in order for the situation we presently find ourselves in, to be quickly resolved.
