The proposal consists of an extension to an existing modern extension, and has the appearance of a piecemeal addition due to the shallow pitch of the glazed roof and awkward junctions with the host building. The design represents a poor-quality, utilitarian addition to the existing modern structures, which themselves relate poorly to the principal listed building. I do not consider that the proposal in itself causes specific additional harm to the character of the listed building as one of special architectural or historic interest because it constitutes a modest addition to previous extensions which have themselves resulted in harm to the setting of the listed building. If minded to approve this application I would suggest that it would be marginally improved by omitting the stone pier to the corner in favour of a fully-timber structure so that it appears as a lighter weight conservatory rather than the hybrid form proposed.
