No objection to these minor works which do not appear to affect the historic layout of the respective properties. However, there is no information on the method of in-filling the doorways. The one to the first floor appears to retain a 19th century-style architrave to the Old Post Office side. It would be preferable for this to be left in situ as a record of a historic moulding, or alternatively relocated to replace some of the adjacent modern architrave. Please clarify method of infilling and request retention of historic architrave.

There are no proposals for reorganizing the spatial arrangement following blocking of the doorways, for example an apparently superfluous large landing will be left to the first floor and to the second floor the two bedrooms will remain interconnecting, limiting privacy. It should be clarified for the avoidance of doubt that this application does not grant approval for any further works than those specifically applied for.
