I write in objection to this planning application - hydraulic fracturing is a notoriously dirty fuel, in terms of its immediate pollution, and in terms of its emissions which ranks it above conventional fossil fuels. With emissions targets set at COP21 fracking is the very antithesis of what we actually need. According to DECC only 19% of people supported shale gas whilst renewable energy had 80%, which begs the question of why would this energy source be pursued when it is clearly not the right thing to do?
