The company are wishing to pump Contaminated water from gas extraction processing into the ground simply to increase their profits. I rely on a 90 metre deep bore hole to provide drinking water for my dwelling and my 4 holiday cottages. Which are located on Cockmoor Road. Contamination of the water aquifers would mean the loss of my business and my dwelling would be uninhabitable. I therefore request that if you decide to approve this extension you or the applicants should provide an insurance policy to provide £10 million pounds compensation to me in the event of any contamination as a result of contaminated water being pumped back into the ground.

Please advise me of NYM's legal responsibility if they approve an application where there are recognised risks to properties and people in the surrounding area.
