I object to the plans to increase the height of this historic old bakehouse building by almost six feet. The street to the front of the building is very narrow and already admits little natural light into the kitchen of "Hunter's Keyhole" opposite. The proposed increase in roof height would further reduce this natural light and also adversely affect the adjoining steps, which have recently been resurfaced by County Council Highways to improve safety.

I also believe that granting this application would be an unwelcome precedent. It would change the character of this corner of the village conservation area and encourage other village property owners to extend vertically in order to provide additional holiday letting space.
