Thanks, Sara.

Hi Jill, I'm happy to concur with Sara's comments. The bat mitigation in Section 9 of the report will need to be conditioned.

To avoid disturbance to breeding birds and loss of habitat for roosting barn owls, which are specially protected, the bird mitigation should be conditioned too. I would recommend that ledges for swallows are incorporated into the development as well, so that this species does not lose nesting habitat.
