Whilst on the face of it an application to convert a field to a runway may seem to have relatively low potential to damage environmentally sensitive sites I would like to point out that adjacent areas of forestry hold breeding populations of three nationally important and threatened bird species namely Honey Buzzard, Goshawk and Turtle Dove. All three species are sufficiently threatened to require protection under Schedule one of the Wildlife and Countryside Act. As a result I wish to submit my objection to this proposal.
