Approve Landing Strip on Ecological Grounds I am involved with an airstrip in the south of England in the New Forest National Park. This is an area of Outstanding natural Beauty and we border a Site of Special Scientific Interest. We are proud of the interest shown by Ornithological and Entomological groups. They seek out our strip for study. Evidently the practice of keeping the main narrow strip mown to about 100 mm year round and leaving the bordering grassland to grow uncontrolled by herbicides and pesticides has produced a healthy environment for birds and insects. The wildlife is unconcerned with the occasional light aircraft movements.
