I am writing in connection with the above specified planning app. regarding the use of a small area of South Moor Farm as an airstrip. I understand that a survey of the surrounding bird and wildlife has recently been commissioned.

I feel that I may just be able to offer some guidance in this, as I also operate a small aeroplane from a grass air strip in rural Sussex named Deanland. At Deanland, we have co-existed over the years very harmoniously with the surrounding rural area and its inhabitants which include; bees, butterflies, dragonflies plus a considerable contingent of birdlife including; Nightingales, Barn & Tawny Owl's, Harriers, Swifts, Swallows and Martins. Also Mammals which include; Field Mouse, the even rarer Dormouse, Shrews, Voles and Pippistrelle Bats.

The adjacent woodland, natural hedging and meadowland is maintained with minimal pesticides and intrusive control methods. The point I am trying to make is that in many cases, land which is utilised as an airfield is able to co-exist with nature more advantageously than land which is not.

I believe that a small air strip at an AONB is actually an asset, as it allows people to visit your beautiful area of Yorkshire and in many cases, small airfields have proved a useful facility for Police/Medic rescue helicopters.

May I take this opportunity in thanking you in acknowledgment of your excellent and responsible custodianship of the area which you serve and I am sure that a solution may be reached which serves as a benefit to all.
