## South Moor Farm – Air Strip

Proposed planning conditions 2016.

- 1. Use only for the operation of light private aircraft. (Under 2000 kg.)
- 2. No, circuit training flights, parachuting, or Aerobatic flights.
- 3. No Glider towing by powered aircraft except after an emergency landing.
- 4. No more than 20 aircraft movements on any one day, with a movement representing a take-off or a landing.
- 5. No more than 500 flights in any one year.
- 6. No landing or taking off of aircraft at the site prior to 7.00 am or after sunset on any day (excepting emergencies).
- 7. No taking off until 30 minutes after sunrise. (To preserve Nightjar.)
- 8. No landing after 30 minutes to sunset. (To preserve Nightjar.)
- 9. The operator to maintain a record of all aircraft movements and, on request, make such records available to the North York Moors Planning Authority.
- 10. The provision of signage on the Bridleway that crosses the end of the site, warning users of those that flying may be taking place.
