I have looked at the reports prepared to address the following conditions for Phase 2 of the development:

4: Ground clearance (including vegetation)

52: Protected Species Management Plans for Birds, Bats, Reptiles

64: Boundaries

76: Soil management

I am content that they have been satisfactorily discharged from an ecological viewpoint, although for bats (Condition 52), I would recommend that some or all of the proposed bat boxes are put in place as soon as possible.

Environment Agency staff will be much better able to assess the reports addressing Conditions 60 and 79 than I am. I note that they are considered to be only partially discharged and that more information is needed. The quantity and quality of water leaving the site is critical for sensitive aquatic species downstream, so I trust that any remaining issues will be resolved to the EA's full satisfaction.
