PLANNING PERMISSION NYM/2016/0518/FL CONDITION 4

The North York Moors National Park Authority (NYMNPA) has previously granted Sirius Minerals Plc (Sirius Minerals) variation of Condition 1 of planning approval NYM/2015/0625/FL to allow an extended temporary timeframe at Doves Nest Farm, Sneaton and granted permission for the proposed development subject to a number of conditions.

Sirius Minerals now seeks approval of NYM/2016/0518/FL Condition 4 by means of submission of this correspondence.

In order to prevent mud, grit and other detritus from being carried onto the public highway from the site the contractor has proposed to use the same methods that have been successfully incorporated at previous Sirius Minerals drilling sites. Sirius Minerals believes the combination of a stoned compound, 10m of bound, hard-surfaced internal roadway and the use of a jet wash on an 'as required' basis will be sufficient to prevent material being carried out onto the public highway. The contractor will employ a road sweeper on an 'as required' basis to ensure that the highway remains clear of mud or other detritus from the site.
