Further to Rowena Sommers' email of 2nd February, I would also like to voice my concerns with regard to the proposed building work at the Victoria Hotel.
My property is next door to that of Ms Sommerville and is also affected by increased land slippage. As has been noted new fencing erected by Mr. Fidler to mark the boundary to the extended car park is leaning. It would appear that the weight of the four cars that this extension can accommodate has caused the land to become unstable.
I am concerned that a sizeable extension with fully tiled roof may well cause further and more serious disturbance to the local topography. This is without taking into consideration the effects of construction due to the presence of heavy machinery and changes to drainage patterns.

I would appreciate your thoughts on the matter.
