Proposed new pavilion at Hackness Grange Hotel For: Mr. Roger Brooks

In response to your email dated 2nd March '17 I would like to confirm the following:

- 1. By complete coincidence, I had just been about to send you the attached plans which show the proposed pavilion substantially reduced in size from the original 12m x 9m (108m2) to 9.6m x 6.6m (63.36m2). This has the effect of reducing the overall bulk of the by some 40%. The reasons for this were twofold, firstly for economic reasons the overall cost had to be reduced and secondly, after discussions with our consultant on the trees, to keep the building further away from the spread of the tree roots. The reduction in the building size has also reduced the roof accordingly.
- 2. I don't think the hipped roof will be heavy in appearance the idea is to clad it with timber shingles which, over time, fade and mellow we think this is most appropriate and the lid will appear to float amongst the trees.
- 3. The whole point of the pavilion was to make it as transparent as possible so that the surrounding trees will be visible through the building and reflected in the glass with the timber uprights echoing the line of trees.

There will only be furniture within the pavilion when a function is on.

- 4. The last thing we want to do is to copy the details of the hotel in any way, certainly not by introducing stonework. The building is intended to be a simple timber "pavilion" amongst the trees and is a completely separate garden feature and not an echo of the listed building. We think this would be quite wrong.
- 5. There is no loss of trees and shrubs the pavilion is sited in a natural clearing in the centre of the island with trees around the perimeter. The only tree which needs to be removed is one that we are advised is diseased.
- 6. Flood Report we are of course aware that the grounds of Hackness Grange are within what the Environment Agency have designated as a Zone 3 flood risk area, namely land having a 1 in Page 2.

100 or greater annual probability of river flooding. Despite bad weather in the past few years the hotel grounds have not flooded and it is thought that general improvements to flood control on the River Derwent have alleviated many of the problems experienced in the past.

In the immediate area the water level in the lake is controlled by a weir so that the water level can be locally controlled. The addition of the pavilion is an extension to the existing facilities and activities taking place within the hotel grounds and the building is designed in a simple robust style to fit in with its surroundings.

Having obtained planning approval for the bridge to gain access to the island, which is, itself, a relatively expensive investment, the purpose of which is to be able to utilise the island for functions as a natural extension to the weddings and other functions now held in the hotel. Hackness Grange therefore needs a building on the island that can be constructed at a sensible cost and which will be able to accommodate functions that will make it economically viable.

I hope that you can agree that the revised scheme meets these criteria.






Proposed New Pavilion at Hackness Grange Hotel


Proposed Pavilion on Lake Island - Interior of Pavilion




Proposed Pavilion on Lake Island - Elevations Revised 2.

Proposed Pavilion on Lake Island - Elevations Revised 1.


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




Proposed Pavilion on Lake Island - location plan









