In relation to the above application, Condition 93 includes a requirement for the applicant to provide the following:

"a scheme for security and lighting during construction;"

Having reviewed the documents that accompany this application, there is insufficient information to enable me to confirm that the terms of this condition have been met. However, having reviewed the Design & Access statement that accompanied Planning Application NYM/2014/0676/MEIA, which contains a specific section relating to security, providing the applicant confirms in writing to the Authority that the points of that section, outlined below, are to be adhered to, then I would be happy for the relevant part of this condition to be discharged.

it is the intention of York Potash to develop a Security Strategy in close consultation with the ALO and CTSAs that addresses both crime and the fear of crime during the construction and operational phases of the York Potash Project

8.16

It is envisaged that security fencing will be used at each of the project locations during both the construction and operational phases. The fence lines can be equipped with perimeter intruder detection such that it acts as deterrence, detector and a delayer. Such equipment could be locally and centrally monitored by York Potash security staff

8.17

CCTV surveillance will be incorporated on all of the sites, feeding back to the C4SRI command centre, where it will be recorded and processed in accordance with accredited procedures. Careful selection of the camera types will be

required at each of the locations to accommodate the different lighting requirements, and in some cases, challenging weather conditions.

8.18

Where appropriate, CCTV cameras equipped with automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) will be installed at the entrances to sites in order to monitor and control site vehicular movement

8.19

Intruder detection systems will be used on buildings and can be locally and centrally monitored by York Potash'sC4SRI command centre.

8.20

Intruder detection systems will be used on buildings and can be locally and centrally monitored by York Potash's C4SRI command centre.

8.23

York Potash will establish, either directly or indirectly, a security workforce to, amongst a number of duties, control and monitor personnel and vehicular access to the various sites; patrol the sites both externally and internally; such personnel and vehicles whilst on site; security vet potential workers and manage emergency, evacuation and business continuity plans and incidents

8.24

Security staff will be deployed at the sites 24 hours a day, seven days a week and throughout all of the year. A minimum of two security personnel will be on a construction site at any one time
