Thank you consulting us on the above application. Subject to the comments about groundwater protection highlighted below being addressed, we have no objections to the partial discharge of conditions in relation to phase 3 of the works.

# Construction and Operational Phase Groundwater & Surface Water Management Plan

- With regard to the proposed dewatering operations during phase 3, the developer should ensure that the monitoring provides the early warning system required to detect any adverse changes in either groundwater level and/or quality.
- In relation to groundwater quality monitoring at the Moorside Farm and Soulsgrave Farm springs, turbidity should added to monitoring suite at these locations.
- Section 3.7.7 a number of proposed water quality sampling parameters for laboratory analysis, for the defined spring sampling locations, appear to be absent from their respective Assessment Trigger value tables. Please revise accordingly.

### Construction Environmental Management Plan

- With regard to the new welfare facilities, please provide details of the expected ground conditions for the associated cesstanks. Has the groundwater vulnerability of these locations being taken into account at both of these locations?
- Appendix 2c (sections 8 and 9.7) with respect to the placement and location of fuel bowsers in relation to watercourses, the sub-contractor should provide an adequate buffer zone to reduce the risk of infiltration to ground via natural ground, excavations or boreholes.
