Application for verification check of conditions 4, 18, 34, 46, 47, 49, 52, 57, 59, 60, 64, 68, 70, 73, 76, 79, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, of planning approval NYM/2014/0676/MEIA at Woodsmith Mine (Formerly doves Nest Farm & Haxby Plantation), Sneatonthorpe Grid Reference 489495 505142

I refer to your consultation on the above application.

This letter confirms the position of the Local Highway Authority (LHA), parts of which have been the subject of email exchanges.

1. Condition 4
The submission relating to Condition 4 is acceptable to the Local Highway Authority with respect to the Phase of the development for which discharge is sought.
2. Conditions 18; 46; 47; 49; 52; 57; 60; 68; 70; 73; 76; 79; 91; 92 and 95.
It is confirmed that the discharge of the above conditions is outside the remit of the Local Highway Authority (LHA). Consequently there are no LHA objections to the discharge of the conditions.
3. Condition 34
Amendments to the submitted Construction Traffic Management Plan (CTMP) are being sought to fully reflect the pre application submissions relating to staff travel to the site and HGV routing to the site. The LHA has provided comments to the applicant to assist with satisfactory revision of the document.

4. Condition 59
The proposal relating to lighting for this phase are satisfactory. Consequently there are no LHA objections to the discharge of the condition.
5. Condition 64
Following the applicant confirming that the fence is set behind the visibility splay to the north of the 'Shaft' access onto the B1416, there are no Local Highway Authority objections to the discharge of the condition.
6. Condition 93
Amendments to the Construction Environmental Management Plan have also been sought. These align with the amendments sought to the CTMP.
7. Condition 94
The construction matters to which this Phase relates are outside the remit of the Local Highway Authority. Consequently there are no LHA objections to the discharge of the condition.
