Note to the Planning Officer:

In assessing the submitted proposals and reaching its recommendation the Local Highway Authority has considered what impact the proposal will have on the highways leading to the site.

The access from the A169 is a public right of way but is not part of the publicly maintainable highway. A number of dwellings appear to have vehicular access along the PROW from the A169. The gated access is not expected to cause any problems for other users of the PROW so long as it does not open outwards.

The applicant has completed a location plan with red line and blue line areas shown. They have not shown evidence that they have a vehicular right of access from the A169 to the plot within their ownership.

Consequently the Local Highway Authority recommends that the following Conditions are attached to any permission granted:

1. HC-07 Private Access/Verge Crossings: Construction Requirements Unless otherwise approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority, there shall be no excavation or other groundworks, except for investigative works, or the depositing of

material on the site until the access to the site has been set out and constructed in accordance with the published Specification of the Highway Authority and the following requirements

e. Any gates or barriers shall not be able to swing over the existing Public right of Way.

The development shall not be brought into use until the approved access is available for use.
