1 Historical Information

The Old Rectory is a substantial stone built house set in spacious grounds

2 Existing site and surrounding area

3 Proposed Description

The development will see the demolition of the existing rear conservatory which is to be replaced with a single storey flat roof extension with a Glazed Lantern and constructed of stone.
