Dear Rob,

Having examined the new photomontages that have been prepared in connection with this revised planning application, I am content that my comments to you of 25 August 2017 and 1 September 2017 still hold with regard to consideration of impact upon heritage assets within the wider landscape. As hypothesized on the basis of our site visit, the D-wall construction stage cranes do indeed have a visual impact of a quite different nature, but of similar scale to the previous proposals. The visual impact of the winding tower stage is not greater than that of the proposed scheme, and the shortening of the duration of this phase is positive in the context of appreciation of the historic landscape. Finally, the photomontages confirm that during the operational stage there will be no impact upon the views from the Whitby headland complex of monuments in particular.
