Natural England is a non-departmental public body. Our statutory purpose is to ensure that the natural environment is conserved, enhanced, and managed for the benefit of present and future generations, thereby contributing to sustainable development.

SUMMARY OF NATURAL ENGLAND'S ADVICE

NO OBJECTION

Based on the plans submitted, Natural England considers that the proposed development will not have significant adverse impacts on designated sites North York Moors Special Area of Conservation (SAC) and North York Moors Special Protection Area (SPA) and has no objection.

Natural England's advice on other natural environment issues is set out below.

European sites – North York Moors Special Area of Conservation and Special Protection Area

Based on the plans submitted, Natural England considers that the proposed development will not have likely significant effects on the North York Moors Special Area of Conservation and Special Protection Area and has no objection to the proposed development.

To meet the requirements of the Habitats Regulations, we advise you to record your decision that a likely significant effect can be ruled out. The following may provide a suitable justification for that decision:

- The retention of existing boardwalks does not represent any material change affecting the site. The boardwalk has previously been given consent by Natural England in order to minimise erosion, damage and disturbance.
