## Vary conditions 2 and 5 of NYM/2016/0880/FL to amend occupancy from holiday accommodation to temporary worker's accommodation at Cloughton Sawmill.

This application has been considered by Council. There were strong concerns expressed as to the precise use requested. While it was acknowledged the application related to people who are to be working on the potash development it was unclear if the word 'temporary' applied to the workers or the accommodation.

Council did not wish to see the area become a permanent development which housed workers (be they permanent employees, temporary employees or subcontractors). However it was prepared to accept that the development could be used as a means of providing accommodation for the workers and subcontractors involved in the construction of the mine.

On the strict proviso that the consent is granted for a period of time limited so that the use does not extend beyond the time of the mine coming into production, Council has no objection to this application. Council most emphatically does not wish the accommodation be used in the longer term for potash workers accommodation and would object should that be the intent of this application.
