Designing Out Crime, I would make the following comments:

1. In relation to the Pay Stations I would refer the Authority to comments made in my previous response

dated 5/2/2015 (copy attached)

2. It is pleasing to see that CCTV is to be installed at both the Pexton Moor and Ebberston sites. I would

remind the Authority that any CCTV system installed must meet the standards required by the Data Protection Act 1998, which states that data recorded with the purpose of identifying individuals

performing criminal activities must be of sufficient quality to do so, otherwise its capture is unjustified.

Therefore, there may be a need to have suitable compatible lighting installed to ensure that there is no

loss of picture quality or colour rendition.

Proposal Revised access arrangements, erection of larch clad shelter and installation of

satellite mast (max height 5 metres) with associated cabinet at Pexton Moor, creation of new access to the north of Pexton Moor, revised access

arrangements and installation of satellite mast (max height 5 metres) with associated cabinet at Ebberston together with creation of new car park, link

footpath to the visitor centre and field access and cattle pen at Visitor Centre Sievedale at Dalby Forest

In relation to the above application my only comment would be in relation to the security of the "Pay Stations", as due to the isolated location of these, they could be vulnerable to attack. It would therefore be advisable that they are emptied on a regular basis and that clear signage be displayed to indicate that there are low levels of cash left inside the stations. Any emptying of the stations should be done at varied times to reduce the likelihood of potential offenders being able to establish the pattern when they are emptied, in order to enable a "cash in transit" foray.

With this in mind, the Authority may wish to place a condition on any grant requiring the applicant to submit written details on what crime prevention measures are to be incorporated to protect the "Pay Stations".
