

Heritage Statement

The proposed development lies within the national park and is to be built on a hardstanding area which forms part of the current farmstead which used to store manure and straw for animal feed and bedding in the open air. The area is partly surrounded by mature hedges which act as a screen for the site which has very limited visibility from any public areas. As such the development will not damage or compromise any existing historical features, heritage assets or landscape features.

The area lies within a conservation area.

The proposed manure store will have an impermeable concrete floor and a roof and guttering to ensure that rainwater is captured and diverted away from the manure significantly reducing the potential for effluent run off and pollution of nearby watercourses.

The proposed development will not only bring about potential environmental benefits but being visible from footpaths that run close to the site will be more aesthetically pleasing than an outdoor manure heap
