The cliff behind the quarterdeck on the application that the applicant claims has not moved since the quarterdeck was built is certainly not stable in 2000 it had extensive land drainage and work carried out to protect the southern part of the village. The cliff path above it is regularly falling away and needing repairing. The property developer that is wanting to build this hot food stall plans to dig into the cliff and dig through the the land drainage for gabion baskets and service trench with gravel seating area and should there be movement that effect nearby properties it will be hard if not impossible to carry out repair works with buildings and services in the way.
