Paul, I presume you will have been updated by Nigel Darcy regarding our site meeting at Knapton power station.

I have been in contact with Shaun at AMEC regarding progress on the review report and although he is making good progress for completion by the end of this week , he has made me aware that he is not going to be able to review the substantial addition documentation within the existing budget. Documents that could not have anticipated at the time of proposal submission have need to be reviewed which are critical to the case, include the Envireau Water Technical Report and Appendix, and the Rockflow Resources induced seismicity report. He anticipates that at the rates previously agreed that the necessary review and reporting of this work will require a **further £1650** of budget. He is carrying on working given the tight deadlines but I need you to confirm whether the extra funding can be approved to complete the report and therefore meet our projected timeline of a consideration at the 19<sup>th</sup> March meeting of the Authority's planning committee.

I look forward to hearing from you on this extra funding request, together with my outstanding request for consideration of a S106 planning gain offer to offset the residual environmental impacts of the development and agreement to of an ' Extension of Time Agreement' to cover the additional time needed over and above the Government target time for dealing with planning applications.
