I am writing in support of the application number **NYM/2014/0587/EIA** made by **Third Energy**

EBBERSTON MOOR: Letter of Support

I have lived all my life at Rains Farm and for the past 20 years I have run a tourism business in Ryedale, adjacent to the North York Moors National Park. Many generations of my family were born and lived high on the moors. The NYM are in my blood and I am a very proud Yorkshire woman. Protecting the beauty and vitality of our countryside is extremely important to me and not something I take lightly.

I believe that The North York Moors National Park Authority should approve the application by Third Energy for the following reasons:

- Approval of this scheme will ensure that two separate gas developments that already have planning approval will be dropped. This single scheme will have a much smaller environmental footprint
- If this application is not approved, it is highly likely that the proposed gas processing plant at Thornton le Dale will be built. This is not what local people want
- This is an existing well-site and the proposal to inject into the well makes more sense than taking it away by tanker or building a new, separate pipeline
- As a major tourism business close to the site I am confident that tourism will not be affected
- Any disruption to the area, flora and fauna will be temporary whilst construction takes place and will soon recover
- New gas supplies are needed to protect jobs at the Knapton Generating Station and the Yorkshire businesses that benefit from supplying it, vital for our local economy
- Finally, we need to produce our local Yorkshire gas rather than import it from far flung places like Russia, Qatar and from across the Atlantic.

I have written in support of this scheme before but, in light of the delays in making a decision, I think it important to write again
