Dear Ms Walker,

After our discussion last week I have erected a temporary 15 metre mast at location number two as shown on the map I supplied last Wednesday. This is my preferred position as I believe this to have the least visual impact on visitors to Dalby Forest.

I have taken some photographs and added images of the proposed wind turbine from three positions that may be viewed by visitors.

From the Deepdale Habitat trail, Photo 1, the proposed turbine and mast are difficult to see being of similar proportions to the high voltage power line poles.

From the entrance to South Moor Farm, Photo 2, the proposed turbine mast appears to be the same height as the high voltage power line poles.

From the Bridleway where it enters the property in the South West Corner, Photo 3, the proposed turbine and mast are more prominent but are passed within 100 metres so do not affect the long distance views.

Photo number 4 is a close up view of the proposed turbine.

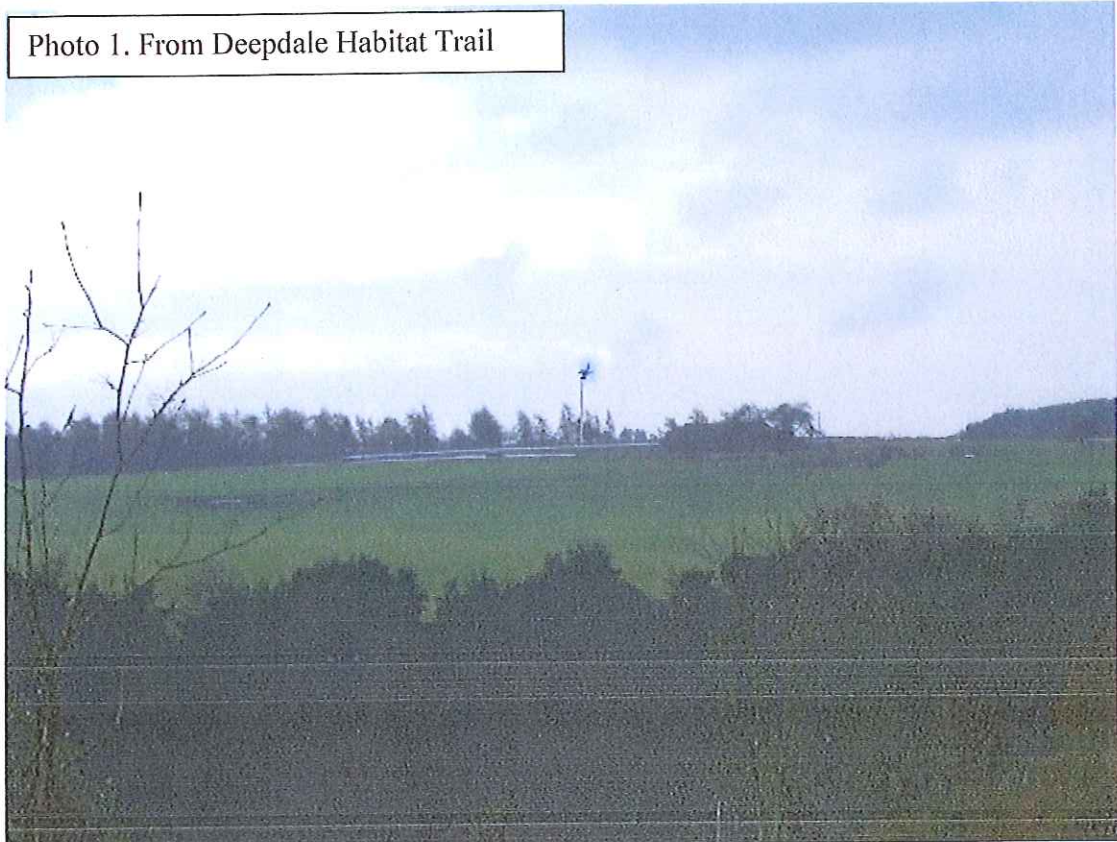

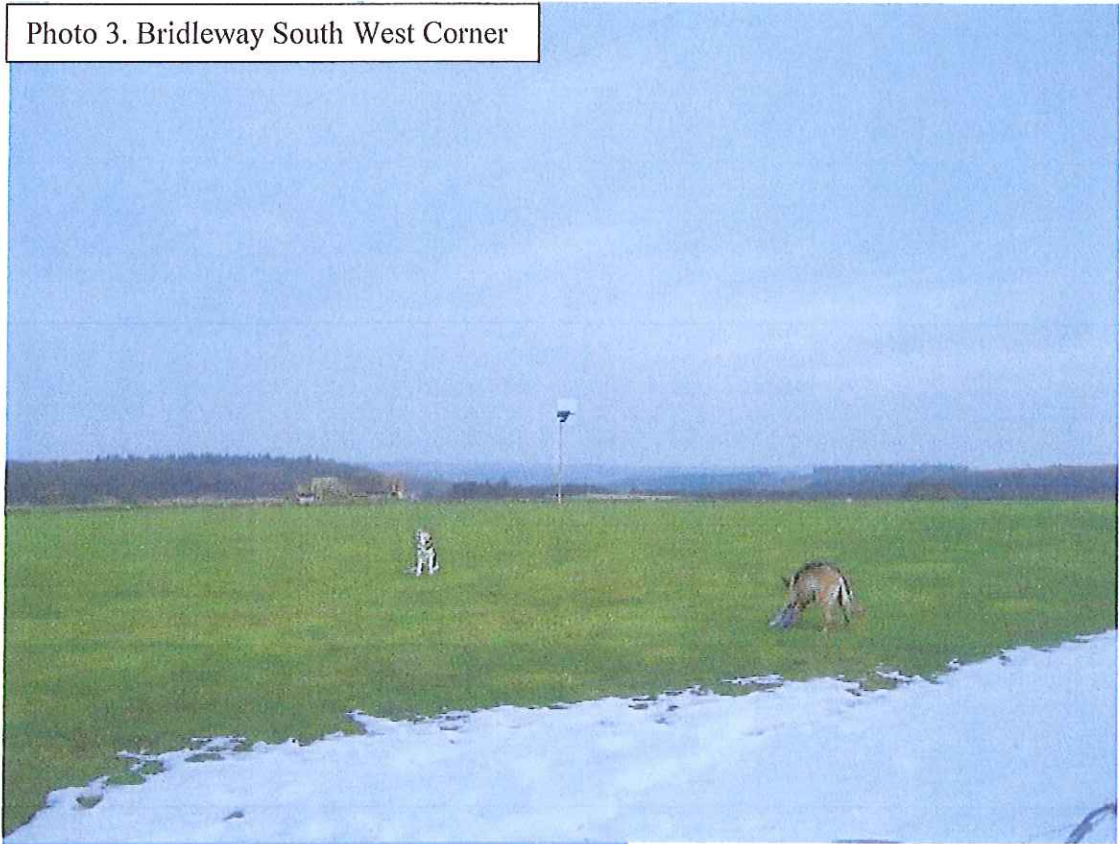
