Outline proposals for Fylingdales C of EVC Primary School

Please find enclosed the proposed alterations to security fencing, play area and car park at the above school.

At present the school has a three-foot high hawthorn hedge at the front of school. The hedge is very thin in places and provides very little if any security for the school grounds. The need for security fencing has been highlighted in our Annual Health and Safety report and also by our Link Advisor for North Yorkshire County Council. In keeping with the local environment and for pleasing aesthetics, the governing body have decided to ask for permission to erect a five foot wooden fence around the front of school and around the infant play area (hawthorn bush to remain). Please be advised the main school playground is elevated and the proposed fence will not obstruct the view of the playground.

At present the infants do not have any outdoor play equipment. The proposed equipment will be of wooden construction and plans are enclosed for your approval.


Our school travel plan has been approved by County and includes the erection of an 8/10 place bike shelter at the rear of school. The shelter would be sited on a concrete base to adjoin the staff car park (see plan) and will not be visible from outside the school grounds.


We would be obliged if this could be given your immediate attention, if any of the above does not require planning permission could you please urgently notify me in order for the work to be commenced.

write with reference to your allocation for devolved capital and your submission detailing how you wish spend this allocation.

can confirm that from an educational point of view we have no objections to this development being indertaken (stage one check). A stage two check, as indicated on the PPF form now needs to be indertaken by the Corporate Property Landlord Unit (CPLU) and a copy of your form has been passed in to them so that they can undertake the necessary landlord role checks. The timescale for CPLU to provide initial comments on work is 8 weeks from submission of the form to Strategic Services. You must, therefore, wait until this timescale has elapsed before you commence this work. For larger schemes you will then need to continue to liaise with CPLU and provide further information as the scheme progresses.

Once you receive CPLU comments on the work the scheme should be progressed having regard to the enancial and self financed procedures that are already in place. The advice and procedures in relation obuilding projects must be adhered to. (NOTE: revised guidance was issued January 2003 — Devolved Capital Building Projects'). Please ensure that your Maintenance Officer is kept fully informed of developments at your school and especially where work now approved is of a maintenance nature. If or any reason you decide not to progress the scheme you put forward and wish to undertake an alternative scheme, you must seek approval from Strategic Services.

The Devolved Capital funding is devolved to schools on code 9601. Schools will need to account for the expenditure by having regard to the Consistent Financial Reporting (CFR), Capital Expenditure Suidelines (issued by Education Finance).

REFERENCE PLANNING APPLICATION – NYMNPA Your ref. NYM/2007/0145/NEW

1 BACKGROUND

Fylingdales School has \$7 pupils. It is on a site in Fylingthorpe with an asphalt playground, turfed areas and several small storage buildings.

The main structure is brick with pitched, semi-pitch and flat roof areas. There is a separate timber classroom.

The school is surrounded by fencing and hedging at present but this is low and insecure. There are two superfluous pedestrian access gates which reduce security.

The school site is owned by the Diocese of York and the buildings by the LEA.

The front hawthorn hedge of the school is set back from the road kerb by about 15 feet with an asphalted footway at the kerb and then grass to the hedge with several cherry trees.

The main entrance for children, staff and parents is from the footway through a Z gateway.

2 PURPOSE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS

- 2.1 To improve security at the front and side of the site.
- 2.2 To reduce access points from three to one for pedestrians.
- 2.3 To improve storage for equipment for school activities.
- 2.4 To fulfil a requirement for a bicycle shed to meet the travel to school plan.
- 2.5 To improve safety in the car park by a minor layout change

3 THE PLAN

3.1 Installation of a 1 ½ metre high timber fence along the front and side of the site with a modified access gate again designed for safety when children and staff are leaving school. The fence will be Tanalith E treated with uprights having castellated tops and 70mm gaps. It will be erected just inside the site close to the existing hawthorn hedge which is already about one metre high. Inside the site the ground rises by over six feet from the road level so that the appearance of the hedge, fence and grassed slope will be well blended.

- 3.2 The access gate has a double bend to slow children down when leaving and then there is a flight of steps up the grass slope.
- 3.3 The infant play area is to be re-equipped and fenced also in the 1 ½ metre castellated timber to provide a secure space. At present it is grassed and half the area will have eco-matting with play equipment.
- 3.4 The equipment is of approved style and standard and includes:
 - A Rattle bridge approx 3 metres long and 1 metre wide.
 - B A tunnel approx 3 metres long
 - C Double balance beam 4 metres long
 - D Monkey bars approx 4 metres long and 1/1/2 metres high
 - E Two small springy animals.
- 3.5 The car park at the rear of the school main building is to be extended by 2 metres in width and across a length of 5 metres and asphalted. This improves layout and accessibility.
- 3.5 The access pathway for all pedestrians from the front gate round the side of the school to the entrance door and office is to be improved with minor changes to levels and kerbing for safety and will be marked clearly. It is necessary to move a large wheeled bin to a new location to be created.
- 3.6 On the field side of the car park opposite the office it is intended to cut back the steep bank by 2 metres along 7 metres with a retaining wall at the back. This area will be concreted and a bicycle shed and wheeled bin sited here. The cantilever bicycle cover is to be 4 metres long and 2.2 metres high of coloured galvanised steel construction.
 - 3.7 Access for disabled wheelchair visitors is to be by the car park entrance on level asphalted roadway direct to the main entrance by the office the widening of the car park makes the access clearer. For sight impaired visitors the normal pedestrian access will be highlighted at gates and corners.

4 IMPACT

As the fencing is of traditional timber construction and 1/1/2 metres high when set behind a growing hawthorn hedge and in front of a steep grassed bank there is no noticeable impact on the view of the school buildings or surroundings.

The play equipment is mainly of timber construction. The bicycle cover unit is coloured steel but is sited at the back of the main building.
