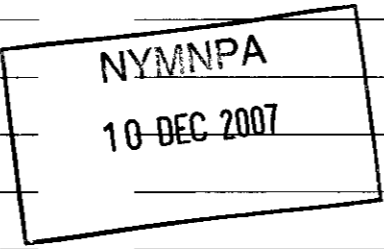

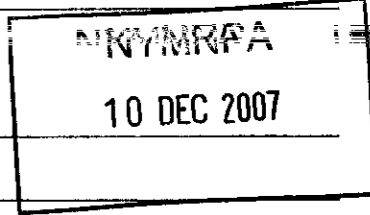

Having recently purchased the above property with Mr Brent Winter we would like to remove a small set of steps so we can place the 1917 soda fountain in the back wall of the shop and ~~under the main stairs~~ in the soda fountain can be a working part of the shop again. The soda fountain is very much a part of Robin Hoods Bay history and we would like to make it a central feature of the shop.

The shop is not very large and we have tried with the help of Beth Davies to refurbish the shop sympathetically. The stairs that we believe to be unoriginal would not be needed as Mr + Mrs Winter who are to live in the upstairs of the building have a separate access ~~from the island~~ to the property and the shop uses the front shop entrance.

The soda fountain is a very heavy item that will have been transported in pieces and bolted together with plaster type sealant in the shop in 1917. It is marble and bolted onto its original base, this I have strengthened, it was freestanding but I would like to secure it to the back wall so this wonderful machine can carry on giving pleasure for many years to come.
