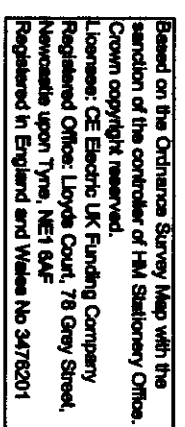

- (a) for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 to install or keep installed an electric line above ground.
- (b) ~~for a direction under SECTION 90(2) OF THE TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 that planning permission for the proposed development be deemed to be granted.~~

1. Particulars of proposed development. It will be necessary for NEDL to rebuild the some of the existing overhead electric lines in the Whitby area to ensure they maintain and deliver a secure and reliable service; in particular the line between Whitby - Sleights West and Sleights Teed Feeder, illustrated on plans numbered C940184 Sheets 3 and 4, revision A. This work will provide substantial support for the network, thereby enhancing system security and improve customer service.

NEDL intend to rebuild the overhead line in its existing position. The existing conductor will be replaced by all aluminium alloy conductor (AAAC), a change that will be indiscernible to the naked eye. There will be two additional structures. These will be positioned at pole 25; and where two poles (31 and 32) replace one existing pole.

In order to meet with current design specifications some poles will require repositioning along the route of the line where existing spans are too great.

New arrangements are needed at pole 2 Sleights to Sleights Church, which will result in slightly less equipment; this is also the case at poles 5 & 6.

Finally, poles 5 & 6 between Ugglebarnby Pumps and Sneaton Eastside will change from a single pole to an H pole and one additional pole. Also in this location a section of low voltage cable will be replaced for a section of underground cabling.

The overall length of the line is 7988m

3. Particulars of the applicant's compliance with his duty under paragraph 1 of Schedule 9 to the Electricity Act 1989.

The majority of the line is within the North Yorkshire Moors. There are no areas of SSSI, Scheduled Ancient Monuments or AONB but Natural England and County Archaeologists have been contacted regarding this. There are also 2 short sections within this line replacement that fall within the Scarborough Borough Council and can be identified between poles 3-10 Eskdaleside Caley SW to Sleights South and also poles 40-54 Cock Mill Wood - Whitby Primary, shown on sheet 3. It is not considered that the electric line will have any impact upon the surrounding landscape due to the line being in direct replacement for the existing line.
