Variation of Condition of NYM2007/0143/FL to Replace Glazing to 4no. South Facing Windows with Clear Glass in Annexe at Rose Lea, Egton.
Your Ref: NYM2008/0438/FL

Further to your letter dated 26 June 2008 please find enclosed four copies of the revised proposals, dwg. no. W/E/10/03 rev C

The revisions include the addition of obscure glazing to Window 5 and the setting back of window frames from the face of the structure by 75mm.

With regards to the position of the frame within the reveal, no improvement is actually achieved in reducing the angle of view out. Reduction is achieved by the actual depth of the reveal to the wall, in this instance with the addition of the internal dry lining, the reveal will be 475mm.

→ Superseded by a phone conversation later the same day where Mr. Watson agreed to a 100mm reveal depth.

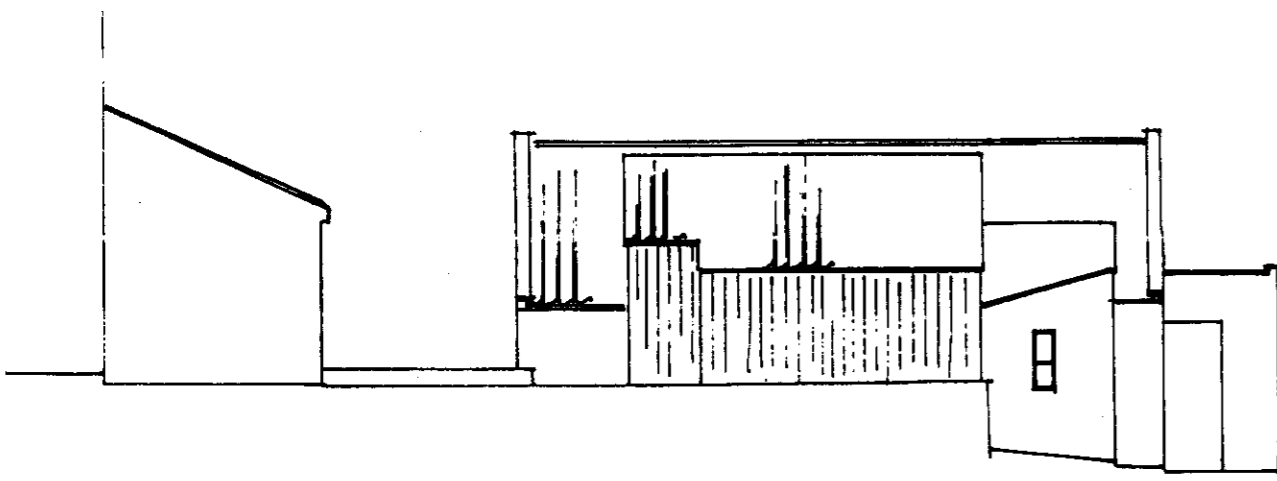

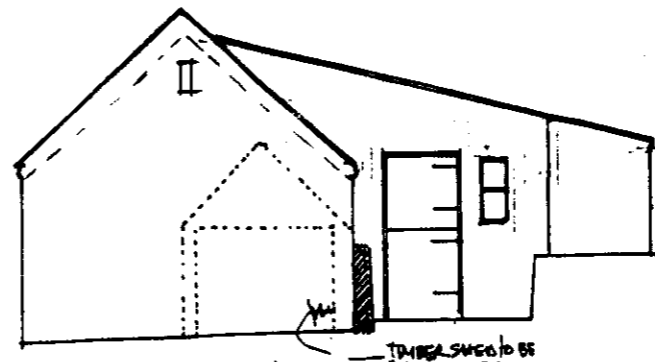

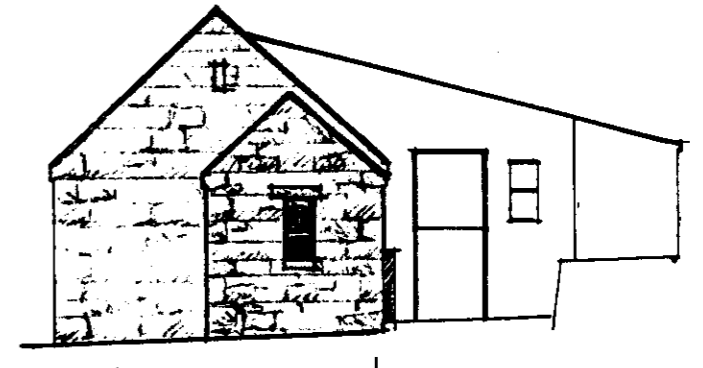

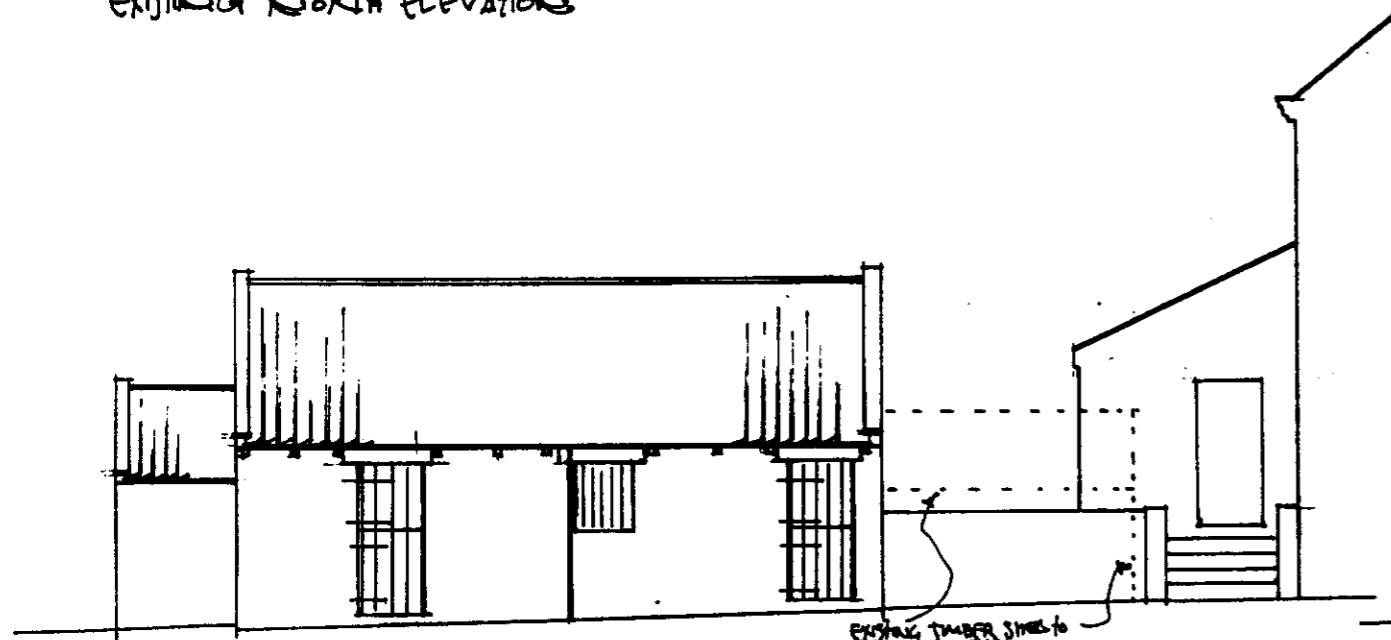
EXISTING NORTH ELEVATION



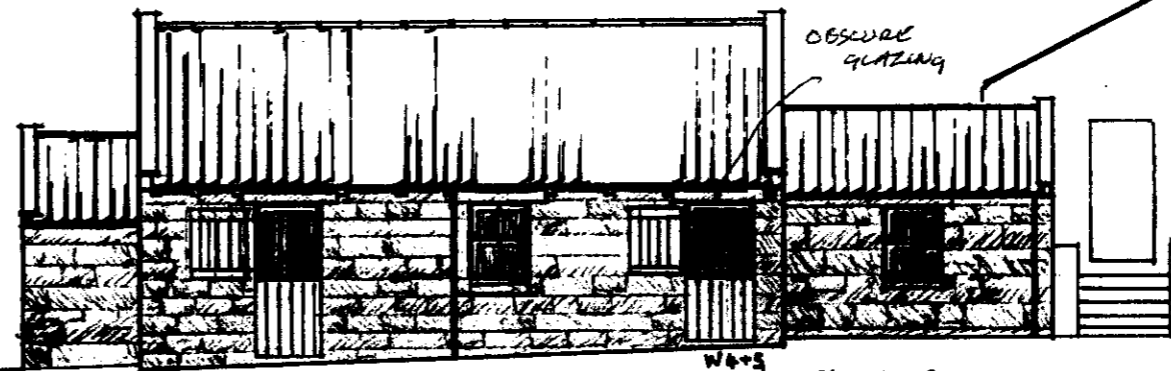
EXISTING EAST ELEVATION

EXISTING SOUTH ELEVATION

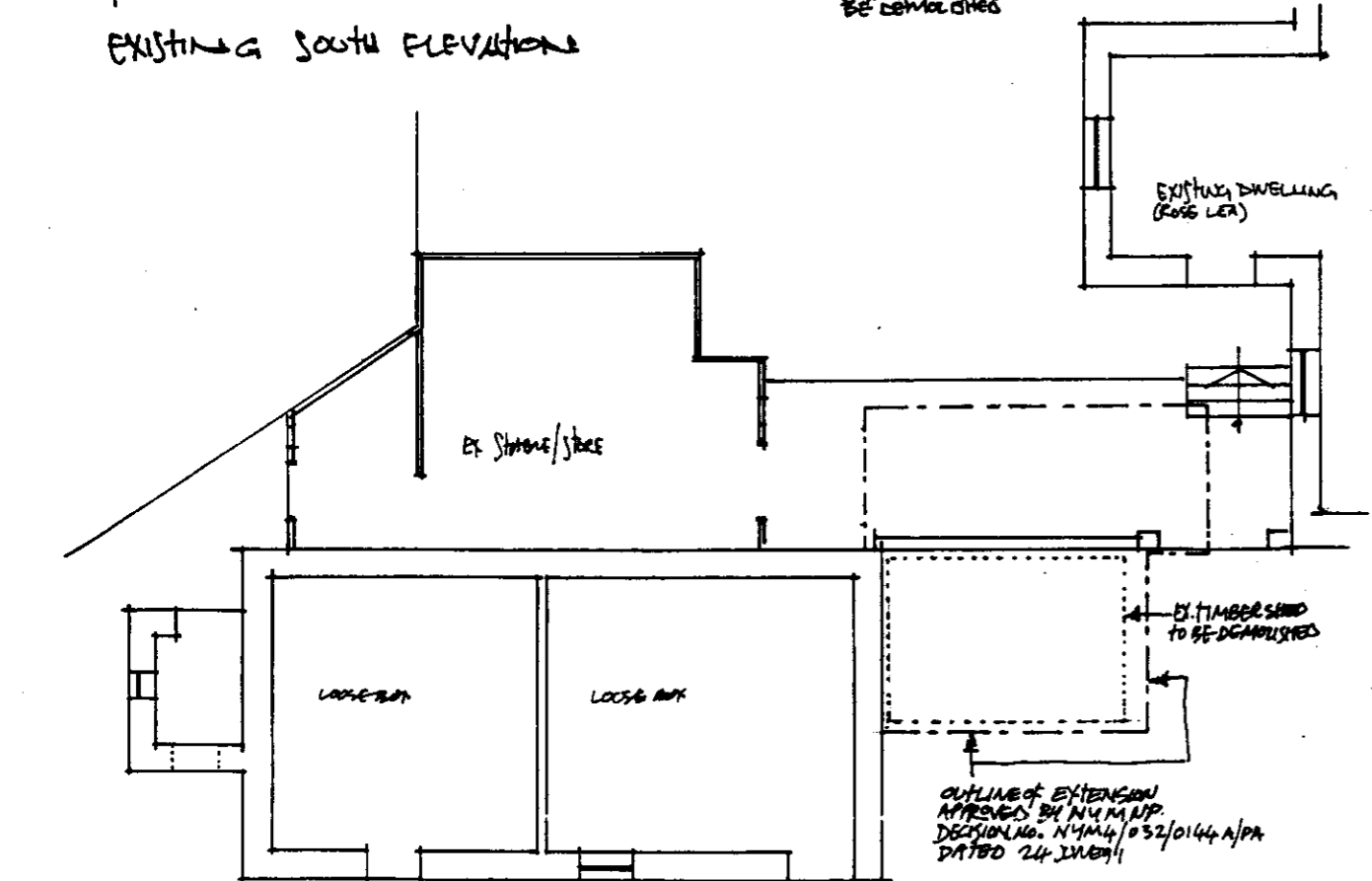


PROPOSED SOUTH ELEVATION

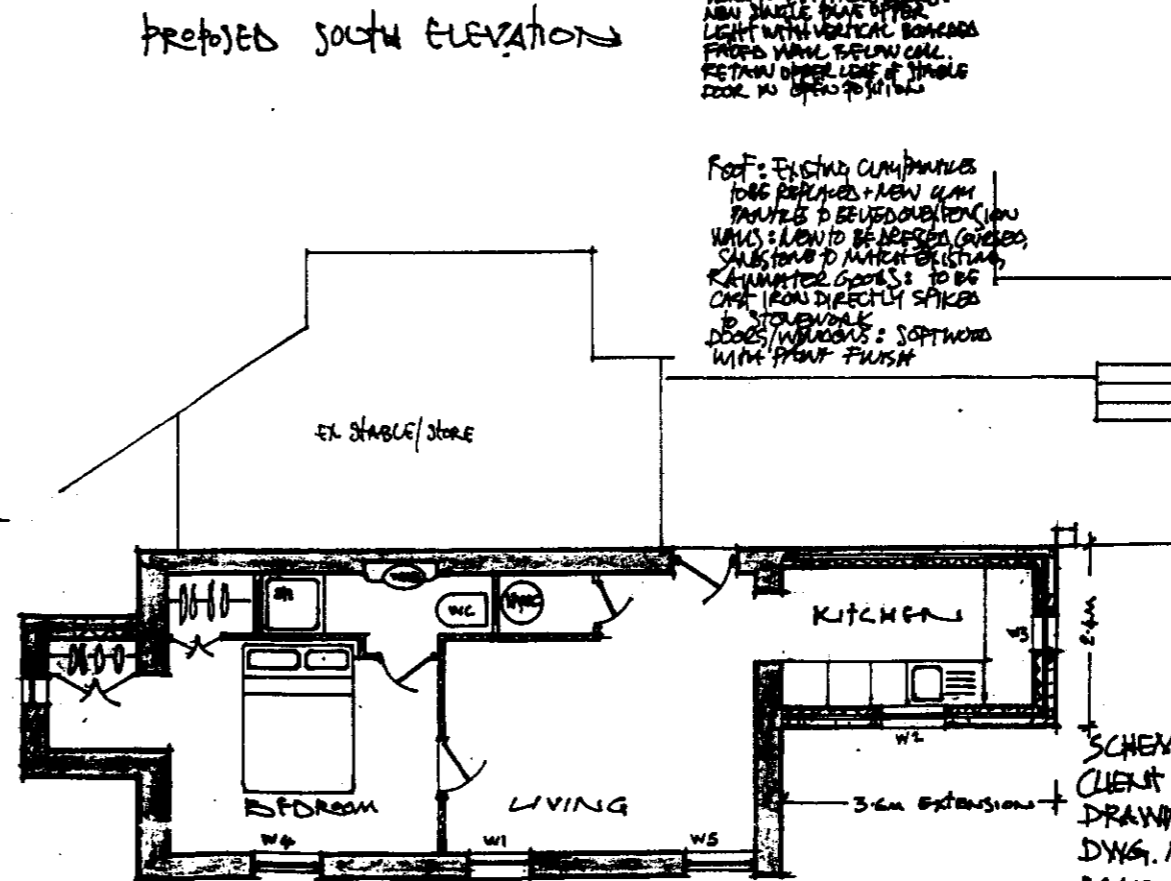
