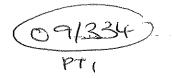

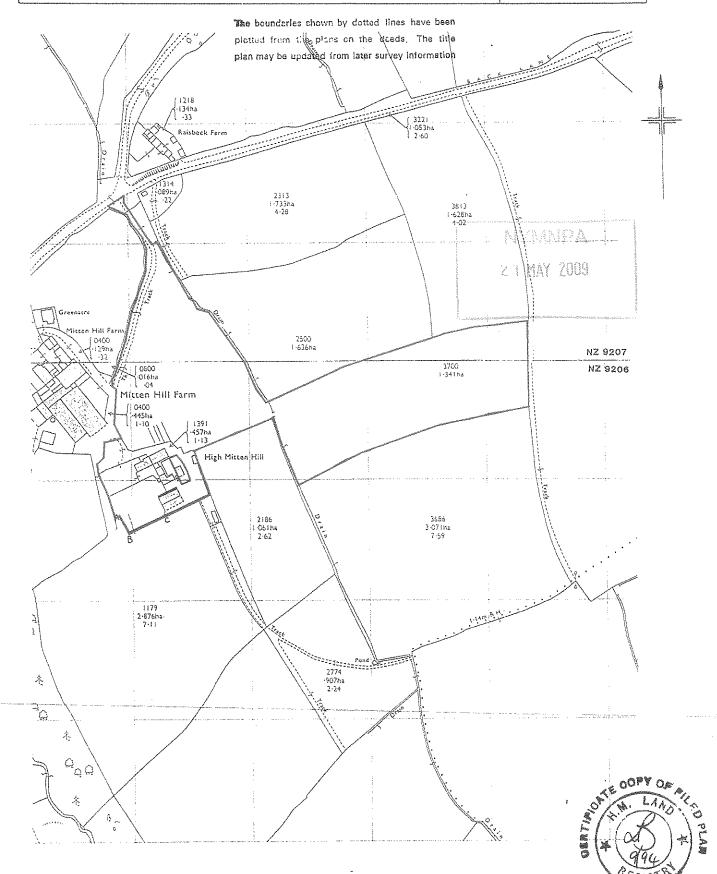

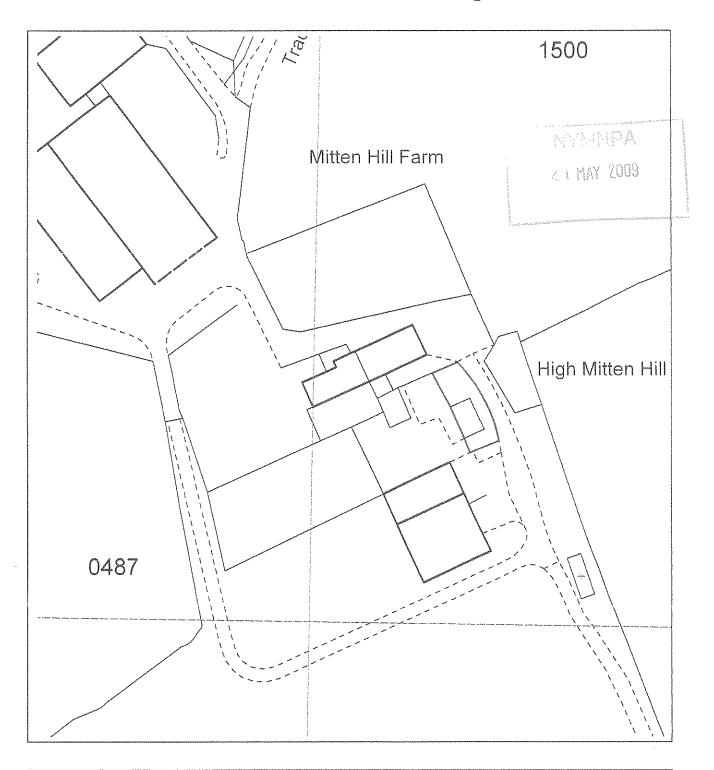

Request for Design and Access statement, further site layout and other information.

On carrying out further research into how to go about preparing a Design and Access statement I frequently came across the following information, this paragraph is actually from a NYMNP publication.

When is a design and access statement needed? There is a requirement to submit design and access statements with all applications for planning permission and listed building consent in the National Park. The only exception to this are those applications involving only a material change of use of land and buildings and those relating to engineering or mining operations.

I would assume from this statement that, as this application is for a material change of use then a full Design and Access statement would not be required, I have however added the following comments to help in this matter.

Design

Design is as planning application NYM/2003/0848/FL

Access

Access is original access as marked in Green on "Parking and Amenity" layout plan, attached.

"High Mitten Cottage" is a detached property which stands to the rear of the farm. The property is totally independent from any other dwellings on the site having its own electricity, water, drainage, fuel supplies.

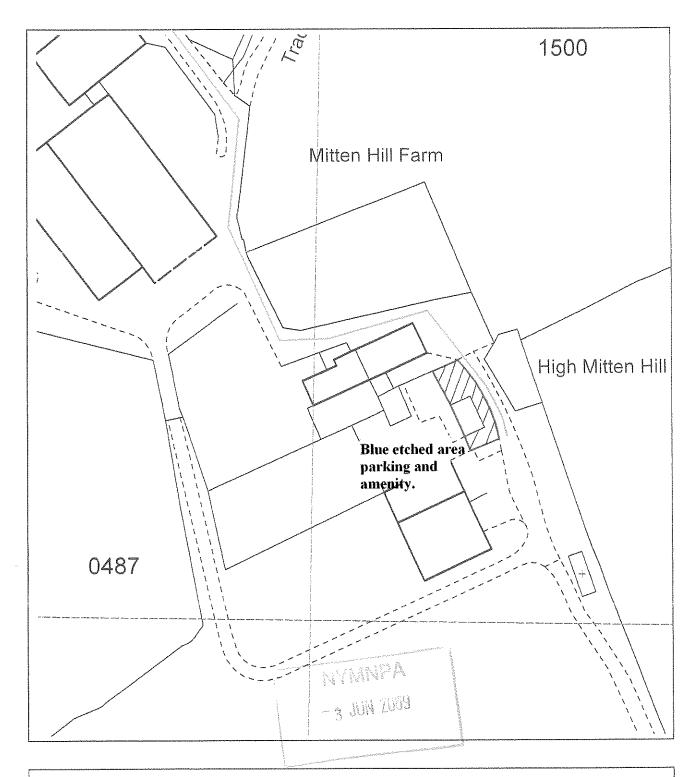
Please find attached 4 copies of site layout, the blue hatched area being parking and amenity areas.
