Appraisal & Physical

Sloping site down to house with permission to extend under approval № NYM/2009/0095/FL. The then proposed garage was deleted from the application.

Single storey timber garage, timber boards external wall, red clay pantile roof and stone plinth. Small domestic scale for a single car.

Landscaping

Domestic garden, landscaping appraisal was visited when the application for the house remodeling was made and remains the same. Existing hard surfacing of the drive is used and 'dry' stone wall around tarmac turning area. Lower reaches of drive now redundant returned to soft landscaping.

Access

From the road as existing. Uses existing drive so far as new garage. A ramped path will lead down from the garage to the house (by clients). There are also existing steps to lower level.
