



The second building was an unstable timber structure with an asbestos roof which has already been removed for safety reasons. This ruinous building was until recently clearly visible from the road in front of the property.



The width (left to right above) has also been reduced by 0.7m to ensure that dimensions are in keeping with the dimensions of the original dwelling. The footprint of the side extension is now approximately 18m2 (28.5m2 n the original application) and the total proposed living space is now less than a third of that in the original application.

The rear extension steps back from the existing building and is reduced in length from 10m in the original application to 9.5m. The ridge height steps down and the side wall steps back midway along the extension in accordance with Park Authority Planning officer's suggestion during the original site visit.










South East Elevation




