The above application has been considered by the Parish Council.

Council has no objections in principle. While the rural diversification and the creation of 20 jobs is laudable, the level of activity does give rise to concerns re. over-intensification and the adequacy of the access road. Passing places on the road are minimal and access for the emergency services is not good. The additional traffic will also have a significant an impact on the residents of Brook and Hawthorn Cottages & Kirkless Farm.

Council is concerned this scheme 1] will generate an unacceptable increase in activity which will harm the character, appearance and natural environment of the area and 2] the existing access arrangements are not adequate for the proposed use and level of activity.

Council request conditions be placed on any consent so as to ensure any dwelling can only be occupied on a letting basis by people meeting the local needs criteria and the dwelling cannot be sold off separately.
