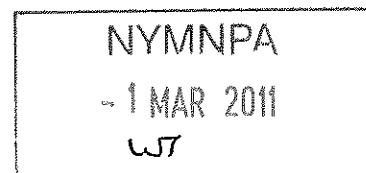

Dear Helen,

Thank you for your email. I'll clarify here what to include in the existing application.

With regard to the dormer window, we have decided to stick with our original proposal therefore Item 12 on the schedule of works will remain unchanged "Second floor, replace single glazing in existing modern windows with double glazing to improve energy efficiency and carbon footprint".

With regard to the bathroom window - please can item No 13 on the schedule of works be amended to request that we replace the existing modern window with a timber frame, sideways sliding 'Yorkshire' sash window in traditional style, clear glass. A photograph of the existing window was included in the original submission. I don't at this point in time have an illustration of the new window as we are awaiting details and price from the builder.

I hope that makes things clear, however if there is any additional information required to help with the decision please get in touch.

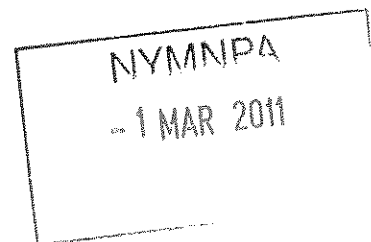
