Thank you for your email. I'll clarify here what to include in the existing application.

With regard to the dormer window, we have decided to stick with our original proposal therefore Item 12 on the schedule of works will remain unchanged "Second floor, replace single glazing in existing modern windows with double glazing to improve energy efficiency and carbon footprint".

With regard to the bathroom window - please can item No 13 on the schedule of works be amended to request that we replace the existing modern window with a timber frame, sideways sliding 'Yorkshire' sash window in traditional style, clear glass.
