I enclose plans of Halfway house showing the footprint which has not changed. I wish to regularise the planning position regarding the old stables attached to the house. Realistically the third next to the house has been used as domestic since before I came here in 1975. & the stables have not been used as such since1984. After that date they have gradually become more domestic. Deep-freezer & wine cellar were incorporated & garden tools & furniture were kept there as were bicycles & garage tools etc as found in most domestic residences. The roof became unsound & was repaired / replaced in 2003 when minor interior work was also done & the alterations to the south wall were carried out. I feel these were done very sympathetically to match & blend with the existing house The builder used was Mr A P Weatherill of Hawsker who can verify the work was done in 2003
