FAO Helen Webster,

I refer to the above application and to our conversation on Tuesday 5th April.

With regard to the issue of the footpath, as far as we can see with the OS plan, the footpath route possibly clipped the corner of the western most cabin. We have moved this cabin slightly so that it does not obstruct the footpath.

In terms of the impact on the landscape of the access road, we would like to amend the construction materials of the access and parking area to 'grasscrete', which is a concrete mesh which the grass can grow through. From a distance, this just looks like grass.

In terms of the possible visual impact of cabins within the landscape. These are well obscured by the existing woodland within which they are sited. The woodland is thin in places and possible views are available from the highway to the west. We are therefore proposing some additional planting as shown on the attached plan. These include two areas of understory planting within the woodland (number 1 & 2), and an area of new planting to the south of the woodland (number 3). The existing woodland provides immediate screening, and the proposed additional planting will provide strengthening to the existing screening.
