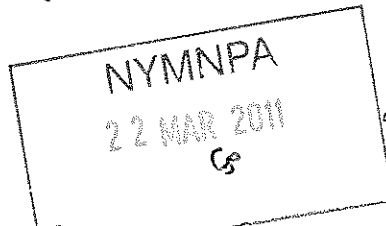

Dear Mr France,
